The acclaimed Los Angeles Art Show moves to its new location at the Los Angeles Convention Center for its 14th annual gathering of art and artists from around the world, January 23-27, 2009. With more than 150 exhibitions from destinations around the globe, this highly anticipated event marks the first time that the LA Art Show will take place in downtown Los Angeles. The LA Art Show is one of the country's most prestigious art expositions featuring

a comprehensive array of artwork spanning cutting-edge contemporary and period works from some of the world's finest artists. The show kicks off with an exclusive opening night gala on Wednesday, January 21st, from 7-10:30 pm, which will benefit the Art Museum Council of LACMA, the Prints and Drawings Council of LACMA, Environmental Media Association, and Inner-City Arts. The show is open to the general public from Thursday, the 22nd, through Sunday, the 25th.
